**New phonic element** *d*

**Words with new phonic element** *bad, Dad, Don, dots, mad, pad*

**Reviewed phonic elements** *n, a, p, m, s, t, o*

**New high-frequency words** *cannot, he, put, see*

**Special considerations** plural ending *-s*;  
inflectional ending *-s*
